**CRWRC Focuses Haiti Response on Leogane**

The Christian Reformed World Relief Committee (CRWRC) is providing emergency response efforts in Haiti on the town of Leogane about 20 miles west of Port au Prince.

"Leogane is a community where 90% of the people have lost their homes," said CRWRC's Disaster Response Director, Jacob Kramer of the town of about 175,000 people. "CRWRC has ongoing programs in Leogane and there is a Haitian Christian Reformed Church there. The people already know us and hopefully we can work with some local leaders as we carry out our relief response."

The United Nations recently reported that Leogane was the area worst hit by the quake. Their local market was already dependent on outside food shipments, and this need has now increased.
