FROM THE OUTREACH TEAM

- Praise God for His blessings on the day at Laos Unity VBS. Thank you to each of you for your prayers, those who donated food and the 12 disciples who served.
- One Body One Hope:
 Sewing machines have been purchased to be sent to Liberia so the older girls at the orphanage can learn a skill. By law, the girls must leave the orphanage at the age of 16. Without an acquired skill and few jobs available, their situation becomes desperate and often either they or others use their bodies as a means of survival. Donations are needed to cover the cost of the sewing machines. This Tuesday, June 29, will be the final day to bring sewing supplies (scissors, pins, needles, tape measures, etc.; no more thread is needed). There is a box marked "sewing supplies" in the Fellowship Hall. Funds for vinyl mattress pads and fitted twin XL sheets are also needed. We have purchased 60 of each of them for a total price of approximately \$20.00 per pad and sheet. If you would like to contribute to either the pads/sheets or sewing machines, please put your donation in the box in the Fellowship Hall. Thanks you so very much.
 A large container will be parked by JFA on July 6 to be loaded with all the goods for Liberia (beds, tables, benches, windows, clothes, books, sewing machines, etc). Please continue to pray for this mission project. God has used your generosity to bless the children and caregivers of the orphanage in Liberia. We praise God!!
