TODAY AT TRINITY

- Today is Palm Sunday, and this morning our children help us remember the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. When Jesus was born, the magi asked, "Where is he that is born king of the Jews?" When Jesus was crucified, a sign was placed on the cross that said, "This is Jesus, the King of the Jews." Ever since the whole world in every generation seems to find it extremely awkward to bow before this humble King, born in a manger and dishonorably crucified on a cross. So on Palm Sunday everyone sings, "Hosanna!" But the question remains, have you given your heart, your soul, and your mind in submission to your King?

EVENING WORSHIP IS A TIME OF PRAYER

- Our worship this evening will be a time of prayer as we reflect on the amazing love our Lord pours out for his people. His sacrifice gives new hope to homes and families, to love and marriage, to field work and factory labor, to office schedules and classroom studies.

GOOD FRIDAY WORSHIP,
